2. Applicants must not previously have entered a professional piano competition in the past ten years.
3. Applicants must not make their living primarily through piano performance.

Venue Located at the beautiful Point Loma Nazarene University in San Diego, California, the competition will be held inside the 378-seat Crill Performance Hall, the centerpiece of the Cooper Music Center.
